How will I learn?

Each module is delivered through lectures and seminars. You will be expected to prepare before classes and participate, particularly in seminars, in class discussions and exercises. For each module there are 40 contact hours, normally divided into 10 hours of lectures and 10 seminars.

We require a further 20 hours independent learning. You will be required to present and interact in seminars (and to some degree in lectures) and, mandatory assessments are set within the first five weeks of each term.

How is my programme structured?

To qualify with an LLM, you are required to study one core module (bearing the name of your selected course) and three elective modules.* You must also complete a 10,000 word dissertation in your core subject.
